Current Business:

1. Purchase of Projector: Need to have Chapter projector for conferences, meetings, etc. Group agreed. ACTION ITEM: Howard Clark will evaluate process, models, etc. once back in San Joaquin Valley.
2. Atwell Island Outreach- Quick Summary (Erin Tennant): Larry Saslaw, Christine VanHorn Job, and Erin Tennant attended. A lot of local kids attended from Tulare, Alpaugh, etc. We brought kit fox mounts, etc. Possibly will be a regular/annual event. Is one at Allensworth annually at the State Park. ACTION ITEM: Erin will check into if this is a regular event.
3. Carrizo Plain botany Field Trip report (Jeff Davis): Chapter member Ellen Cypher led field trip in April for about a dozen participants. A lot of rare species observed, some of which are still being determined/identified. Will be a possible repeat for spring 2016, day or camping trip, possibly at CDFW's Chimineas ER/house.
4. Student Grant Application (Erin Tennant): Erin has UC Santa Cruz student working on a blunt-nosed leopard lizard (BNLL) and climate change project with and whom will submit a grant application. He presents at the Natural Communities Conference and is a long term Chapter member. Everyone OK with reviewing an application now, Board members will review. ACTION ITEM: Erin will email application out once received.
5. "Meet Up" Group Creation (Renee Robison): Costs \$15/mo. Group would be pretty open, but can include questions to filter. Members could not post directly. Already possible with yahoo group, also similar to gmail group. After much discussion, the group decided that this is probably not appropriate for the Chapter.
6. Workshop Updates (all):

- Tracking WS: Nov 14-15 at Windwolves. Planning on Camping. Windwolves is asking for a donation to use the facilities of \$20/participant. Sunday will use Windwolves buses to go to higher elevation areas. Will be \$95-100 per person cost for Jim Lowery to put on the WS. Discussed possibility for having a caterer, since there won't be a lot of time to cook/prepare meals, but we want to keep costs low. Would include lunch, dinner, and breakfast at campsite (plus away lunch). We discussed requirement for participants to bring their own food, we can provide snacks. Jim Lowery has new edition of book out, could include in cost of WS. He also has a canid leaflet. ACTION ITEM: Jeff Davis will follow up re insurance. We will also advertise to Chapter members (so they have priority), can advertise more broadly if still have openings.
 - Urban Ecology Workshop: Are we still interested? Yes. ACTION ITEM: Kris Robison will reach out to a few potential presenters. Possible for Fall 2016. Jeff Davis said that possible to do a joint event with AEP. ACTION ITEM: Jeff Davis and Lori Bono will follow up.
 - BNLL Workshop: Possible in spring 2016. Possible to do both BNLL and plant workshops in early 2016? Decided to pursue spring 2016 BNLL workshop, without binders, can post info online. Should possibly do at a hotel, should plan on 50 people. Should avoid CSUB given past facility issues. Chimineas is a possibility.
 - Botany Workshop: Maybe decide in Jan 2016 if we have good rainfall.
7. Future Donation for USFS Ranger Week (Erin Tennant): Would we be interested in donating again (to pay for school buses to provide transportation for disadvantaged schools). Yes. ACTION ITEM: Erin Tennant will follow up, we would like to have board member or chapter member attend as well.
 8. Student/Professional Lunch with CSUB Bio Club (Erin Tennant): Could we sponsor a lunch? Could include free lunch for students, maybe in Bakersfield in November, could repeat at CSU Fresno. Group was interested. ACTION ITEM: Erin Tennant to follow up.
